

## Covid-19 Update: April 14th 2021

Our camp is open with the following requests and mandates, from our State and local Health Depts., CDC, and the Camp. Please follow these as close as possible. Check this page often as it can change daily. Our restrooms are open but we ask that you use your own restrooms when you can and make use of our dump station when you leave. When using our restrooms please limit the number of persons in them at one time, and be aware of physical distancing. Stay safe, keep others safe.

We at Maiden Rock West will do our best to keep our campers as safe as is possible through this health, social and economic pandemic.

### **COVID-19 NEED TO KNOW Information:**

- POOL is **opened** with limited use hours, approx. 11am - 7pm. Limit is 15 - 20 people with swim time of 1 hr. Please allow other campers time to swim, you come back again later.
- The pool restrooms are opened only during pool hours. Porta-potties are provided by the parking lot and sites P12 & P16.
- The pool restrooms also serve as our emergency shelter and **WILL BE OPEN** for **WEATHER RELATED SAFETY. Masks are required, with social distancing** (as much as possible).
- Use Social Distancing 6ft. guide lines throughout campgrounds. Respect your neighbor's right to "safe zone "camping.
- **WEAR YOUR MASK - Not limited to:** When at the office, visiting your neighbors or going to other sites, having your own visitors. Using any of our outdoor recreation, Use of the restrooms (when opened).
- Camp Office walk-up window on right side of the building should be used for CHECK IN. This limited contact window will also be used to purchase supplies, snacks, firewood, ice, etc.
- Disc Golf Course is OPENED with social distancing. Use the green honor basket at the office, \$5 per person, \$10 for the day.
- Parents should monitor their children on playgrounds to ensure proper physical distancing is enforced. Play is at your own risk.
- ALL OTHER PLAY: For volleyball and basketball, bring your own ball, no more than groups of 10. Ask office for clean ball, please return to the office when you are down. Same for horseshoes.
- WASH PICNIC TABLES: When you get here and before you leave. Help keep yourselves and others safe.
- VISITORS: \$4 adults, \$3 kids. Park in the parking lot not on sites (seasonal also please let your families know to park in the parking lot not your site.) Unless you have ambulatory difficulty, there are exceptions, Please ask.
