Our camp is open with the following requests and common sense from Maiden Rock West Camp, State and local Health Depts., CDC. Please follow these as close as possible. Check this page often as it can change daily.

We at Maiden Rock West will do our best to keep our campers and camp as safe as is possible through this health, social and economic pandemic.

COVID-19 NEED TO KNOW Information:

- Check in at the office. Please limit to one family group in office at a time. Camp Office walk-up window on right side of the building can be used for CHECK IN when we get busy.
- Our restrooms are open but we ask that you use your own restrooms when you can and make use of our dump station when you leave. When using our restrooms please limit the number of persons in them at one time, and be aware of physical distancing. Clean up after yourselves. Stay safe, keep others safe.
- POOL is opened from approx. 10am - 8pm. Limit is 20 - 30 people. Please allow other campers time to swim, you come back later.
- Use the Physical Distancing 6 feet guide lines throughout campgrounds and when around those you don't know. Respect your neighbor's right to "safe zone" camping.
- Parents should monitor their children on playgrounds
- WASH PICNIC TABLES: When you get here, and again before you leave. Help keep yourselves and others safe.
- VISITORS: \$5 adults, \$4 kids. Park in the parking lot not on sites (seasonal also please let your families know to park in the parking lot not your site.) Unless you have ambulatory difficulty, there are exceptions, Please ask.
